Categori Ieithyddol / *School's Language Category*

Ysgol Gynradd Gymraeg benodedig yw YGG Gellionnen. Tra bod nifer o blant yn dod o gartrefi Cymraeg eu hiaith, daw y mwyafrif o gartrefi cwbl ddi-Gymraeg ond erbyn iddynt gyrraedd tua 5 oed mae'r plant yn siarad yr iaith yn hyderus ac yn naturiol. Mewn ysgolion cyfrwng Cymraeg fel YGG Gellionnen addysgir cwricwlwm y Cyfnod Sylfaen (3-7 oed) yn gyfan gwbl drwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg. Cyflwynir Saesneg yn rhan o'r Cwricwlwm Cenedlaethol ym mlynnyddoedd 3 hyd at flwyddyn 6 ond Cymraeg yw prif gyfrwng yr addysgu â'r gweithgareddau allgyrsiol. Nod sylfaenol yr ysgol yw darparu addysg ddwyieithog i'n disgyblion a fydd yn eu galluogi i ennill hyfedredd yn y Gymraeg a'r Saesneg. Mae'r ysgol yn rhoi pwyslais ar feithrin ymwybyddiaeth o Gymreictod a chariad tuag at ein gwlad a'n hiaith yn ein plant. Ar derfyn eu cyfnod yn yr ysgol bydd disgyblion yn medru parhau â'u haddysg trwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg yn Ysgol Gyfun Bryn Tawe.

Ysgol Gynradd Gymraeg Gellionnen is a designated Welsh primary school. While many children come from Welsh-speaking homes, the majority of the school's children come from non-Welsh-speaking homes, but by the time they reach around 5 years of age, the children speak the language confidently and naturally. In Welsh medium schools such as YGG Gellionnen the Foundation Phase curriculum (3-7 yrs) is taught entirely through the medium of Welsh. English is introduced as part of the National Curriculum in years 3 to 6 but Welsh is the main medium of instruction and extracurricular activities. The school's fundamental aim is to provide bilingual education to our pupils which will enable them to gain proficiency in Welsh and English. The school places emphasis on fostering in our children an awareness of Welshness and a love for our country and our language. At the end of their time at the school pupils will be able to continue their Welsh medium education at Ysgol Gyfun Bryn Tawe.

Adroddiad Blynyddol i Rieni / *Annual Report to Parents*

Mae'r Corff Llywodraethol llawn wedi cyfarfod yn dymhorol i drafod materion yn ymwneud â'r ysgol yn ogystal â derbyn adroddiadau gan y Clerc, y Pennaeth a chyflwyniadau amrywiol gan athrawon a'r disgyblion. Mae'r ysgol yn derbyn nifer o ddogfennau oddi wrth Senedd Cymru a'r Awdurdod Addysg Lleol ac rydym yn trafod, ac yn gweithredu yn ôl yr angen.

Yn sgil Deddf Safonau a Threfniadaeth Ysgolion (Cymru) 2013, a ddaeth i rym ar y 4ydd o Fai 2013, mae canllawiau newydd ynglyn â threfniadau cyfarfodydd Llywodraethwyr â Rhieni. Yn fyr, golyga hynny:-

- nad oes raid i gyrff llywodraethu ysgolion gynnal cyfarfod blynyddol i rieni bellach
- bydd yn ofynnol i gyrff llywodraethu ysgolion gynhyrchu a dosbarthu adroddiad blynyddol i rieni
- os bydd 10% o rieni disgyblion cofrestredig yr ysgol neu rieni 30 o'r disgyblion sydd wedi'u cofrestru yn yr ysgol - pa un bynnag o'r ffigurau sydd isaf - yn gofyn am gyfarfod â'r llywodraethwyr, mae'n ofynnol i gorff llywodraethu'r ysgol gynnal cyfarfod
- gall fod yn ofynnol i gorff llywodraethu ysgol gynnal hyd at 3 chyfarfod i rieni bob blwyddyn academaidd os bydd deiseb yn gofyn am hynny

The full Governing Body met on a termly basis to discuss matters relating to the school as well as receiving reports from the Clerk, the Head Teacher and various presentations from teachers and pupils. The school receives communication from Senedd Cymru and the Local Education Authority and all correspondence are discussed and acted upon as necessary.

As a result of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013, which came into force on the 4th of May 2013, there has been a change in procedures of Governors meetings with Parents., In short, this means that:-

- *it will no longer be necessary for school governing bodies to hold an annual meeting with parents*
- *it will be necessary for school governing bodies to produce and distribute an annual report to parents.*
- *if 10% of the parents of registered pupils at the school or the parents of 30 pupils registered at the school – whichever is the lower number, request a meeting with governors, the school governing body is required to hold a meeting*
- *a school governing body can be required to hold up to 3 meetings with parents each academic year should a request be submitted.*

Materion Cyllid / *Financial Matters*

Derbyniwyd y gyllideb gan y Llywodraethwyr ac fe fu'r is-bwyllgor Cyllid yn monitro'r gwariant. Ni hawliodd y Llywodraethwyr unrhyw daliadau costau a chynhaliaeth yn ystod y flwyddyn. Derbyniwyd £150 mewn roddion gan yr ysgol yn ystod 2023-24.

The budget was approved by the Governors and was monitored by the Finance sub-committee. The governors did not claim any expenses for travelling or subsistence during the year. £150 was received in donations by the school during 2023-24.

Adolygwyd y prosectws a gwnaed man newidiadau i adlewyrchu dyddiadau ac ystadegau cyfredol yn ogystal ag arolwg o Amcanion a Nodau'r ysgol ar gyfer y flwyddyn 2023-24, yn unol â'r canllawiau a dderbyniwyd gan Senedd Cymru. Yn unol â rheolau statudol dosbarthwyd y llawlyfr yma i rieni plant sy'n cychwyn addysg llawn amser yn yr ysgol. Mae copi ar gael o'r swyddfa i'r sawl sy'n dymuno ei dderbyn a hefyd, mae'r prosectws yn cael ei roi ar wefan yr ysgol. Mae cytundeb cartref/ysgol yn cael ei ddosbarthu yn flynyddol.

The school's prospectus for the academic year 2023-24 was reviewed and amended according to the Senedd Cymru guidelines. To comply with statutory regulations a copy of the prospectus has been issued to parents/guardians of pupils commencing full time education. Upon request, a copy is available in the office and the prospectus is posted on the school website. A home/school agreement is distributed annually.

Cynllun Gwella Ysgol / *School Improvement Plan*

Cymerwyd camau i weithredu ac adolygu strategaethau'r ysgol – Cynllun Gwella Ysgol 2023-24. Mae gwybodaeth yn cael ei gasglu yn gyson drwy fonitro trylwyr gan yr UDRh a chydlynwyr pwnc. Cesglir y gwybodaeth er mwyn bwydo mewn i ddogfen Hunan Arfarnu. Llwyddwyd i gyrraedd y targedau canlynol a osodwyd ar gyfer y flwyddyn.

The pupils responded brilliantly to the content of the texts, showing understanding when discussing content.</p> <p>The school has led on a multilingualism project within Partnership and has collaborated with Dr Eowyn Crisfield, Oxford Univerity, to develop the translanguaging element. Dr Eowyn Crisfield has held meetings with RhR to decide the course of research and they are very excited to discover the effect the pedagogical method has, on the relationship between applied linguistics and language pedagogy and the pupils' output.</p> <p>Mrs Chen and Mr Wen, continue to work with Year 4, 5 & 6 pupils and Bethan Williams introduces French to year 6.</p> <p>The school has been successful with a British Council application to develop Wales-France school Partnerships with a focus on Celtic sports or cycling. Some of Mr Wen's pupils managed to gain an international qualification after taking the YCT1 Mandarin exam.</p> <p>After the success of last year's Dragon Boat Festival Mrs Chen continues to prepare the Mandarin choir for further performances. The pupils were also very fortunate to spend a day in the company of Mrs Chen and the teachers of the Confucius Institute - they had a taste of Chinese culture and also had the opportunity to visit the ICT Immersion room IQ centre of Trinity St David's University.</p> <p>We Continue to collaborate with the secondary school as a powerful tool to ensure consistency in basic language work.</p>

Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol (ADY) / *Additional Learning Needs (ALN)*

Mae polisi Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol (ADY) yr ysgol yn cydymffurfio â Chôd Ymarfer yr Awdurdod Addysg Lleol. Mae'r polisi yn cael ei adolygu'n flynyddol gan y Cydlynnydd. Fe benodir aelod o'r Corff Llywodraethol i arolygu'r ddarpariaeth ar gyfer ADY. Mae'r ystod a gynhwysir o fewn anghenion ychwanegol yn eithriadol eang, o blant a datganiadau swyddogol hyd at blant disglair sy'n teilyngu gwaith ymestynnol i gadw eu diddordeb a datblygu eu galluoedd. Gan fod yr ystod o anghenion ychwanegol yn yr ysgol, rhaid darparu ystod o ddarpariaeth arbenigol i ateb anghenion y plant. Bwriadwn i bob disgybl elwa'n llawn o'i gyfnod yn YGG Gellionnen; rhaid felly darparu'n llawn ar gyfer pob angen a gosod strwythurau yn eu lle i fonitro a darparu ar gyfer yr anghenion hynny. Addysgir y plant mewn dosbarthiadau o allu a rhyw cymysg ymhob blwyddyn yn yr ysgol. Erbyn hyn darperir cymorth dysgu i blant ag Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol o fewn y dosbarthiadau a thu allan. Mrs Caroline Williams yw cydlynnydd anghenion dysgu ychwanegol yr ysgol ac mae'r cynorthwyyr yn cefnogi disgyblion o fewn a thu allan i'r dosbarth gan gynnwys sesiynau un i un 'Derbyshire'. Mae côd ymarfer ADY y sir yn cael ei weithredu. Mae adnoddau yn cael eu casglu at ddibenion ADY ac mae ystafell wedi ei adnodi at y pwrpas. Mae'r seicolegydd addysg ac aelodau o dîm cefnogi ADY y sir yn ymweld â'r ysgol yn rheolaidd. Cynhelir arolwg ADY bob mis Hydref. Mae'r ysgol yn cydweithio gyda'r Uned Iaith a Lleferydd a leolir yn YGG Bryn Tawe.

The school's Additional Learning Needs (ALN) Policy fully complies with the Local Education Authority's Guidelines and the Welsh Assembly's Code of Practice. The school's head teacher along with the Additional Learning Needs co-ordinator review the policy annually. A member of the governing body is appointed to oversee the provision for ALN. The spectrum included within additional needs is very wide, from children with an official statement to exceedingly bright children who deserve extension work to maintain their interest and develop their abilities. As there is a spectrum of additional needs in the school, a range of specialist provision must be made available to meet the needs of the children. We intend for every pupil to profit fully from his/her period at YGG Gellionnen; full provision must therefore be made available for every need and structures put in place to monitor and provide those needs. The children are educated in mixed ability and gender classes in every year at the school. Help is provided for children with Additional Learning Needs within the classroom environment and in specific individual and group situations outside the classroom. Mrs Caroline Williams was the Additional Learning Needs Co-ordinator during the year along with class assistants support pupils inside and outside the class including 'Derbyshire' one to one sessions. The ALN. code of practice is in operation at the school. There are resources for teaching ALN and a room is equipped at the school for Additional Learning Needs The education psychologist and county support staff for ALN visit the school regularly. An Additional Learning Needs survey is held in October each year. The school works with the Speech and Language Unit based at YGG Bryn Tawe.

Amddiffyn Plant / *Child Protection*

Mae diogelwch a lles ein disgyblion yn bwysicach nag unrhyw ystyriaeth arall. Mae'r Pennaeth neu aelod o'r tîm arwain ar ddyletswydd bob bore a phrynhawn i sicrhau diogelwch y disgyblion.

Mae staff ar ddyletswydd am 8.40yb gyda'r drysiau a gatieau yn cau am 8.50yb. Rhaid i unrhyw un sy'n cyrraedd yr ysgol ar ôl yr amser hwn fynd i'r dderbynfaf i gofrestru. Mae cyfnodau dyletswydd staff yn dilyn patrwm debyg yn ystod y dydd wrth oruchwylio'r neuadd ar iard yn ystod amseroedd egwyl. Mae aelod dynodedig o staff sydd â chymhwyster Cymorth Cyntaf ar gael ar gyfer pob amser egwyl.

Aelodau dynodedig staff sydd a chyfrifoldeb am amddiffyn plant yw Mr Davies (Pennaeth), Mrs Thomas (Dirprwy Bennaeth), a Mrs Sweeney (Arweinydd Lles). Ers Gorffennaf 2018, Swyddog Amddiffyn a Diogelu Plant o fewn y Sir yw Ms Lisa Collins.

The safety and well-being of our pupils is more important than any other consideration. The Headteacher or a member of the leadership team is on duty every morning and afternoon to ensure the pupils' safety.

Staff are on duty at 8.40am with the doors and gates closing at 8.50am. Anyone who arrives at the school after this time must go to reception to register. Staff duty periods follow a similar pattern during the day when supervising the hall and the yard during break times. A designated member of staff with a First Aid qualification is available for each break time.

Designated members of staff with responsibility for child protection are Mr Davies (Head), Mrs Thomas (Deputy Head), and Mrs Sweeney (Welfare Leader). Since July 2018, Ms Lisa Collins is Child Protection and Safeguarding Officer within the County.

Cyfleusterau i ddisgyblion ag anabledd / *Provision for pupils with disabilities*

Ein nod yw creu cyfleoedd cyfartal i bob disgybl. Ceir rhai cyfleusterau i'r anabl ar y safle. Mae'r ysgol yn cael ei haddasu yn gyson ar gyfer pobl ag anabledd corfforol. Mae rhai rampiau wedi cael eu codi ar gyfer mynediad i bob adeilad a buarth ac mae yna doiled i'r anabl. Gweithredir ar yr egwyddor o sicrhau fod adnoddau ar gael i ddisgyblion anabl er mwyn eu galluogi i ymroi'n llawn ac i sylweddoli eu potensial llawn o fewn cymuned yr ysgol.

Our aim is to provide equal opportunities for all pupils. The school has some facilities for the disabled. The school is continuously being adapted for use by disabled children and parents as and when limited resources become available. Ramps are in place for access to all buildings and yards and there is a disabled toilet on site. The governors and teachers are committed to the principle of accepting disabled pupils and to make every facility available and accessible to them so that they can participate fully to realise their own full potential within the school society.

Toiledau / *Toilets*

Mae toiledau ymhob adeilad ac maent yn cael eu glanhau yn ddyddiol.

There are toilets in every building which are cleaned on a daily basis.

Cyngor Ysgol / *School Council*

Mae dau aelod o bob dosbarth o Flwyddyn 2 i Flwyddyn 6 yn cael eu dewis drwy etholiad i gynrychioli eu dosbarth ar Gyngor yr Ysgol. Mae'r Cyngor yn gwneud penderfyniadau ynglŷn â pha elusennau i gefnogi, a sut i godi'r arian yma.

Pupils from each class from Year 2 to Year 6 are elected to represent their class on the School Council. The school Council make decisions regarding which charitable organisations to support and how to do so.

Ysgolion Iach / *Healthy School*

Rydym yn aelod o Ysgolion Iach Abertawe a Mrs Eleri Mackey yw'r cydlynnydd. Hyrwyddir blychau bwyd iach i'r plant sydd ddim yn derbyn prydau bwyd ysgol. Ni chaniateir siocled na chreision fel byrbrydau. Buom yn cydweithio'n agos gyda Mr Roger Dutton, Swyddog beicio SUSTRANS, i ddarparu cyfleoedd beicio a sgwtera diogel i ddisgyblion yr ysgol gyfan. Cwblhaodd Crefft heol yr hyfforddiant ymwybyddiaeth o ddiogelwch ar y ffyrdd yn llwyddiannus gyda blwyddyn 2. Mae gennym ddwy ffynnon ddwr lle gall y plant lenwi eu poteli dwr fel bo'r angen. Anogir y plant i yfed dwr yn ystod y dydd.

We are part of the Swansea Healthy School initiative and Mrs Eleri Mackey is our co-ordinator. Children are encouraged to bring healthy lunchboxes to school if they do not have school lunches. No chocolate or crisps are consumed as snacks during break times. We worked closely with Mr Roger Dutton, SUSTRANS cycling officer, to provide safe cycling and scootering opportunities for pupils throughout the school. Kerb craft successfully completed the roadsafety awareness training with year 2. We have two drinking fountains where the pupils can fill their water bottles as needed and they are encouraged to drink water during the day.

Llysgenhadon Chwaraeon / *Sports Ambassadors*

Mae'r Llysgenhadon Chwaraeon yn parhau i weithredu o fewn yr ysgol yn hyrwyddo chwaraeon fel arf bwerus ar gyfer iechyd a lles. Cydweithio'n nhw'n wythnosol gydag arweinydd Llythrennedd corfforol y sir i ddarparu sesiynau i grwpiau o blant ar draws yr ysgol i wella medrau disgyblion.

The Sports Ambassadors continue to operate within the school promoting sport as a powerful tool for health and well-being. They collaborated weekly with the county's Physical Literacy leader to provide sessions for groups of children across the school to improve pupils' skills.

Llysgenhadon iaith / *Welsh Language Ambassadors*

Mae nifer o brofiadau ieithyddol wedi deillio trwy wrando ar lais y disgybl ac wrth drafod gyda'r athrawes gyfrifol. Oherwydd eu bod yn mwynhau sioeau byw, trefnwyd taith i Theatr Na nÓg i wyllo perfformiad gwych o *Heliwr Pili Pala* ac i'r Neuadd Les yn Ystradgynlais ar gyfer Dysgu Creadigol Hansel a Gretel. Rhannwyd testun trafod yn wythnosol i sbarduno trafodaeth o fewn y dosbarthidau a buddsoddwyd yn rhaglen ddarllen, DarllenCo.

Cydweithiodd y llysgenhadon gydag aelodau Menter Iaith Abertawe wrth arwain gemau buarth. Mwynhaodd y disgyblion y profiad o baratoi ar gyfer y cwis lyfrau, Cwis dim clem a chael y profiad o gydweithio gyda staff yr ysgol i ddatblygu cynllun gweithredu siarad drwy dy het.

A number of linguistic experiences have resulted from listening to the pupil's voice and when discussing with the responsible teacher. Because they enjoy live shows, a trip was organised to Theatr Na nÓg to watch a wonderful performance of the Butterfly Hunter and to the Ystradgynlais Welfare Hall for Hansel and Gretel Creative Learning. A discussion topic was shared weekly to stimulate discussion within the classes and we invested in a reading programme, DarllenCo.

The ambassadors collaborated with Menter Iaith Swansea members in leading yard games. The pupils enjoyed the experience of preparing for the book quiz, Cwis dim clem and having the experience of working together with the school staff to develop a talk through your hat action plan.
