Road closure on Lone Road at the junction with Sam n Bens

We have had confirmation that works to improve the safety of motorists and pedestrians at the junction of Gallionnen Road and Vardre Road will start on the 12th May. Lone Road will be closed from this time up until 6th June. There will be diversions in place during this time. There is no doubt this is going to cause significant disruption.

We have discussed this in great depth with council officers. Unfortunately due to the layout of roads, there is no other option than to close this section of the highway whilst the work takes place.

This section of road has long been a dangerous junction. Widening the carriageway, and adding a pavement to both sides will significantly improve the safety of road users, those walking up Lone road. It will also make a real difference to the overall safety of those at the bottom of Gellionnen Hill, including motorists, pedestrians and school children.

From 9th June until 25th July, the road will reopen, but with a traffic light system in place.

We ask you all to please bear with these diversions. Whilst it will cause disruption, this work really is needed. Please think about leaving extra time for your journeys to work, school and other appointments.
